## 2. Carver Elementary – Principal June Johnson reviewed the following:

- Crossings & crossing guards – June discussed student safety and cross walks at:
  - Jonathan Carver Parkway & Ironwood Drive
  - Ironwood Drive and Hartwell
  - Initially, two adults will be at each crosswalk to assure safety of the students. This will be monitored during the first couple of weeks of school
  - Routes for students to walk to school were described

## 4. Jonathan Carver Parkway & Ironwood Drive Intersection Plans – Joe McGough provided an overview of the enhancements at this intersection. Additional crosswalk striping will be added on the north and east side of this intersection. Two additional pedestrian crossing buttons will be added at the intersection. Work on this intersection should be completed by August 21<sup>st</sup>.

## 5. Jonathan Carver Parkway (JCP) Signage, Speed Zones – Dan McCormick provided an overview of enhancements to Jonathan Carver Parkway (JCP). A

40 mph school zone will be established near the school and school zone signs will be added to JCP. Carver County will continue to monitor traffic flow, speed, crossings and signals. Dan noted that with future growth, roads will be developed which will provide additional routes to Carver Elementary School from the north and south.

6. Patrolling – Deputy Lessard and Deputy Tyler Stahn noted that the sheriff's department will be patrolling the neighborhoods and will be at or around the JCP/Ironwood intersection for the first couple of weeks of school.
